

## Single Patient EHI Extract for Soarian Document Management

Single patient EHI extract for Soarian Document Management is provided by using the **Export to Media** functionality within the solution.

To meet the required extract specifications, the user in Soarian Document Management must adhere to the following:

- 1) Select documents for one and only one patient. The documents selected could be in various document formats such as PDF, XML, TIF, JPEG, TXT.
- 2) Use the PDF in ZIP option to render all of the documents selected into a single .PDF file.
- 3) For the encryption setting, choose None.
- 4) Select the Include Header/Footer option.

The .Zip file that is created for the Single Patient EHI extract is a standard WinZip file that can be processed by standard off the shelf WinZip processing tools. The name of the .ZIP file is MRN.ZIP where MRN is the medical record number for the patient data extracted.

The .Zip file will contain 2 files:

- 1) A readme.txt file that has standard information about the certification of the solution and a link to the Oracle Cerner website for more information about EHI extracts. The readme.txt file does not contain any patient information or any information related to the specific extraction performed.
- 2) A PDF file. The PDF file will be named MRN.PDF where MRN is the medical record number for the patient data extracted. The single PDF will contain all of the documents chosen by the user that performed the extract. There are no markings in the PDF to separate documents. However, page headers and footers embedded in the pages of the PDF allow for visual identification of what pages belong to what documents.

The PDF will contain a Table of Contents. The Table of Contents will show the following:

- a) A heading for the medical record level only if documents were extracted that were associated to the patient but not a specific encounter. The heading will show the medical record number. Within that medical

record heading is a list of the documents associated to the patient but not a specific encounter that were extracted.

- b) A heading for any encounter for which there were documents extracted that were associated with that specific encounter. The heading will show the Encounter number.
- c) The order of the documents shown in the Table of Contents when all sections are expanded represents the order that the documents appear in the PDF file.
