Integration Overview

Oracle has validated the integration between the Concardis CPG hAccept POS application and Oracle Payment Interface 6. Customers using Oracle Hospitality's property management systems (PMS) can now use Concardis' integrated payment application at points of sale equipped with the Concardis CPG hAccept PIN entry device (PED).

Integration Details

Oracle Payment Interface communicates to the Concardis CPG hAccept PED over the merchant's local area network (LAN) through a secure HTTPS connection. Oracle Payment Interface then connects to the on-premises version of Oracle Hospitality OPERA 5.5 PMS. The PED mapping table is handled by Oracle Payment Interface.

The integration enables the following:

- Pre-authorization of transactions at guest check in.
- Incremental authorization (top-up) during the stay.
- Automatic authorization release in case a guest wants to pay with a different card than the one provided at check in.
- Sale completion transactions with the same card provided at check in.
- Dynamic currency conversion (DCC) handled on the PED side. Oracle Hospitality OPERA PMS will always receive transaction amounts in local currency.
- Purchase and refund transactions.
- Void transactions.

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- End-of-day settlement transaction to inform Concardis when Oracle Hospitality OPERA starts the end-of-day procedure.
- Get token transactions to request the Concardis PED to read a card and provide a token.

Get token (bulk) and get PAN (bulk) transactions are not supported. PAN data can only be keyed in from the Concardis PED and initial tokenization of PAN data stored in the Oracle Hospitality OPERA database is not possible. Additionally this solution does not support interfaces that handle credit cards, such as but not limited to ADS, OPERA Xchange Interface (OXI), OPERA Web Services (OWS), and OWS-KIOSK.

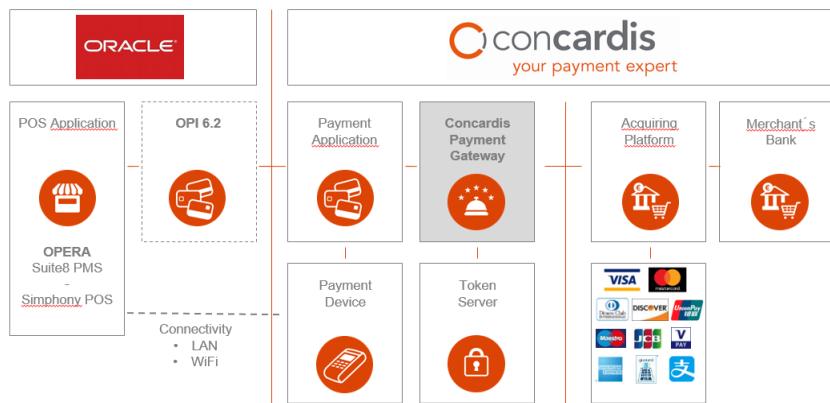


Figure 1. Integration architecture
