GC Universal Payment Gateway is a bridge between Oracle Payment interface and payment hardware.

GC Universal Payment Gateway integrates with Oracle Hospitality OPERA property management system (PMS) via Oracle Payment Interface, enabling hoteliers to interface with bank or third-party payment platforms that support different payment devices with fixed or mobile terminal processing and a variety of payment methods, such as Alipay, WeChat pay, and UnionPay. The integration improves the speed and accuracy of check-in and check-out transactions and payments from Oracle Hospitality OPERA.

With UPG's connection and conversion processing, various payment terminal and mobile payment methods—such as Alipay, WeChat Pay, and others—can interface with Oracle Payment Interface and hence be connected to Oracle Hospitality OPERA.

Integration Details

Oracle Payment Interface communicates to UPG via a middleware mode. The integration supports the following functionality:

- · Preauthorization of transactions
- Incremental authorization (top-up)




Figure 1. Integration architecture between Greencloud UPG and Oracle Payment Interface
