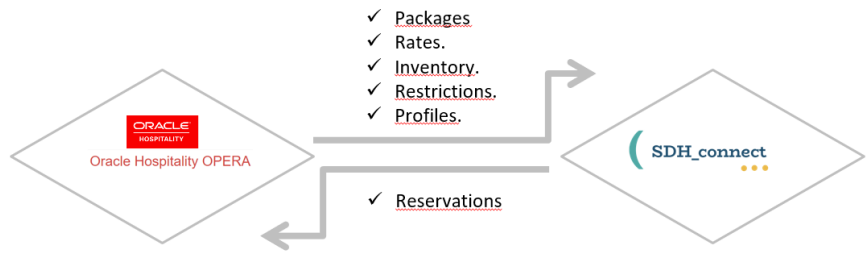


Figure 1. Illustration of the two-way data flow between Oracle Hospitality OPERA and SDH_Connect. The integration is also available with one-way data flow.

- Triggers inventory from Oracle Hospitality OPERA PMS
- Triggers restrictions from Oracle Hospitality OPERA PMS
- Triggers rates and packages from Oracle Hospitality OPERA PMS
- Triggers corporate and travel agent profiles from Oracle Hospitality OPERA PMS

XML versions used at each integration point are:

- Reservations use XML version 5
- Profile uses XML version 5
- RTAV uses XML version 4
- Restriction uses XML version 4
- Rate uses XML version 6
