The solution is validated with West 8006 and West T103, but Oracle Payment Interface is supported on all West card terminal models. All devices have contactless capabilities and support dynamic currency conversion (DCC).

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Integration Details

All card transactions are initiated by the Oracle Hospitality application installed at the merchant location. The terminal, running WPA, communicates with West Payment Gateway (WPG) over a secure and encrypted line for online authorization. The gateway validates the information and switches the transaction to the corresponding card network while also returning the result of the transaction back to the card terminal. The card terminal then informs the Oracle Hospitality application about the result of the transaction.




Figure 1. Integration architecture

You can configure and update the card terminal remotely, on a schedule, or on demand. In addition, you can configure terminal capabilities such as transaction types allowed, card schemes accepted, how many offline transactions should be allowed, and more.

The West Payment Solution is a combination of three main products: card terminal hardware, WPA, and WPG. The solution is certified with the Payment Card Industry (PCI) standards and with all major card brands with global reach through multiple acquirers reaching Europe, Asia, Australia, and South Africa.
