




Architectural Overview Standby OMSs using Standby WebLogic Domain

When is Upgrade and Transition necessary?

Candidate environment

- Currently implemented DR in EM 12c using Standby WebLogic Domain
- Need to continue to implement DR in EM 13c using Storage Replication
- One or more of the following conditions:
 - OMSs/OMS Agents (Central Agents) not configured with alias hostnames
 - Inventory for OMS and/or OMS Agent not on replicated storage
 - Or not in a location that can become replicated storage without symbolic links
 - OMSs/OMS Agents not on replicated storage
 - Or not in a location that can become replicated storage without symbolic links

When is Upgrade and Transition necessary? Environment that does NOT require Upgrade and Transition

- Currently implemented DR in EM 12c using Storage Replication
 - OMSs/OMS Agents (Central Agents) configured with alias hostnames
 - OMSs/OMS Agents installed on replicated storage
 - OMS/OMS Agent installs associated with inventory on replicated storage
- In this scenario, standard Upgrade is sufficient
 - Ensure that locations remain on replicated storage
 - Pay attention to certain related issues post upgrade
 - Local lock file locations
 - Regenerate demo certs (or re-implement custom certs) using alias hostnames
